GENERAL INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE: Classes should be attended regularly as every class missed will put the student behind the others. There will be no refund if classes are missed. Please call or email if you know that your child will be absent from his or her dance class.

REFUNDS: If a decision is made to terminate classes during the year, all remaining post-dated cheques or remaining balance will be returned upon written notification. There is also no refund on costume deposits after November 1st.

COSTUME FEES: A costume deposit of \$50 per class is due by Nov 1st. You may pay this anytime before the 1st of November. The remainder is due upon pick-up. Costume fees vary from class to class. Combo classes' -ex. Tap/Jazz is considered one class and does not require two deposits.

PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS: Please notify the studio immediately about any injury or limitation your child might have. This allows us to ensure a safe teaching environment for your child.

PARENT VIEWING: Parents may not sit inside the classroom to watch classes. Please watch from the window or on the television in the lounge. As of March, the windows will be covered in order to keep recital dances a "surprise" for parents.

YEAR-END RECITAL: All students, participate in the Year End Recital. This is the student's chance to perform and show their family and friends what they have accomplished during the year. If your child is unavailable for any aspect of rehearsal during this time, please let studio know that your child will not be available to participate.

RECITAL TICKETS: Recital tickets are all purchased online. Those that do not have a credit card, please seek the assistance of a family member to purchase your tickets online. Online tickets have eliminated the 4-5 hour wait to purchase tickets!

Tickets will go on sale in May. Each family is guaranteed a certain amount of tickets. Tickets go on sale the general public 2 weeks after the family pre-sales.

GENERAL INFORMATION

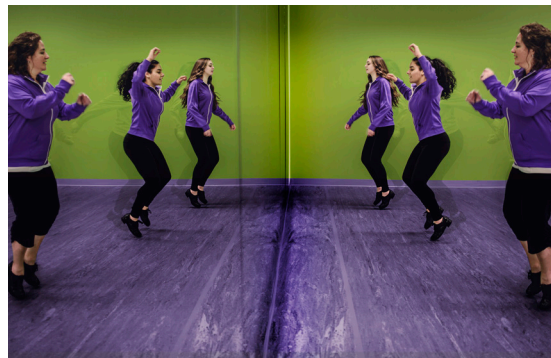
QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS: All instructors at Dance Evolution are educated and experienced in teaching dance to children. However, we also know that nobody knows a child better than his/her parent. If at anytime questions or concerns arise, please do not hesitate to discuss them with your child's instructor or the Director. We ask that you do this during non-teaching hours so that the instructor may give you their full attention without taking away from the class.

GROOMING: This is an extremely important aspect of dance. Hair must be in a bun or off of the neck for ballet and tied back in a ponytail or something similar for jazz, tap or creative dance. Proper dance clothes must be worn at all times. In chilly weather a zip-up hoody can be worn for the beginning of class. Please allow your child to understand the importance of being properly prepared for their class.

FOOD & DRINKS: Absolutely no food or drinks in the change rooms or classrooms at anytime. Dancers and parents may eat in the lounge area or hallways. Dancers are allowed to bring water bottles into the class.

LOCKERS: Lockers are for competitive dancers only. They are reserved for senior dancers then inter, junior and lastly minis.

PARKING: We have 12 spaces in front of our building. After 5pm you are welcome to park in the Days Inn parking lot in the 10 spaces closest to Lorne St. Please note that meter parking on weekends and after 6pm is free. You may also use the Dalron and Bay Used Books parking lots after 5pm for any overflow parking. Please look both ways when entering and existing the building.
